

Sense of the Senate resolution regarding tenured and non tenure track faculty:

Acknowledging all the many and diverse contributions made by non-tenure track faculty to the academic mission of Syracuse University, and

acknowledging the need for flexibility in meeting the needs of the University in a changing higher education context,

the Syracuse University Senate reaffirms the essential centrality of full time tenured and tenure track faculty who play the full range of academic roles in research, teaching and service in an integrated way, supporting the mission of Syracuse University as an R1 research university committed to excellence in scholarship and teaching,

The University Senate expresses its sense that the success of the University as a center of integrated research and teaching requires that tenured and tenure track faculty should constitute the overwhelming majority of the full time faculty.

The University Senate calls upon the University Administration and the University Trustees to affirm that though there is an important role for non tenure track faculty in particular situations, the success of the University as a center of integrated research and teaching requires that tenured and tenure track faculty should constitute the overwhelming majority of the full time faculty.
